

A summary of the fixed SID Figures for January 2025, provided by the Norley Community Speedwatch Group

In summary

Vehicles continue to exceed the prosecution speed limit on Delamere Road, Norley Road and School Bank. The speeding figures for Delamere Road, Fingerpost Lane and Norley Road are slightly reduced from previous months.

The fixed SID devices continue to exhibit a low level of reliability.

Ashton Road (Exit Speed)

Only 8 days of data was available on the device. The max speed recorded for those days was 50 mph.

Blakemere Lane (Peak Speed)

The device will not connect via BlueTooth and is only displaying speed intermittently.

Delamere Road (Exit Speed)

48.2% (55% for Dec) of vehicles exceeded the 30 mph speed limit. 16.3% (21.3% for Dec) of vehicles exceeded the prosecution speed limit of 35 mph. The figures are slightly reduced from the previous month. **The maximum exit speed was 65.3 mph.**

Fingerpost Lane (Peak Speed)

10.8% (13% for Nov) of vehicles exceeded the 40 mph speed limit. 0.7% (1.3% for Nov) of vehicles exceeded the prosecution speed limit of 46 mph. The figures are slightly reduced from the previous month. **The maximum peak speed was 56.8 mph.**

Norley Road (Exit Speed)

24.2% (29.3% for Dec) of vehicles exceeded the 30 mph speed limit. 8.1 % (10.8 for Dec) of vehicles exceeded the prosecution speed limit of 35 mph. The figures are slightly reduced from the previous month. **The maximum speed was 54 mph.**

School Bank (Peak Speed)

86.4% of vehicles exceeded the 20 mph speed limit. 55.3% of vehicles exceeded the prosecution speed limit of 24 mph. **The maximum Peak speed was 43.2 mph.**
